Race 1 - 6:05pm. THE VISIT racingtv.com HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)





Permission was given for WALK THE MOON to wear a red hood to the start.

The Starter reported that TIAMAT (IRE) refused to enter the stalls and was withdrawn at 6:07pm. Edward Bethell was informed that the filly could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

The performance of AL TARFA which finished unplaced, was considered. The representative of William Knight explained that the gelding was unsuited by the Good going on this occasion and may benefit from a return to an all-weather surface. Their explanation was noted. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of AL TARFA during routine testing, failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Race 2 - 6:40pm.

THE JILL WILCOX-JONES MEMORIAL HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for AUSDAISIA (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 3 - 7:15pm. THE BRITISH EBF FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for EXPENSIVE QUEEN (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 4 - 7:50pm. THE GLOBAL MATERIALS HANDLING LTD HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Following the race, Alistair Rawlinson reported that ROYAL PLEASURE (IRE), unplaced, stopped quickly.

<u>Race 5 - 8:25pm.</u> THE JOIN RACING TV NOW NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for POET MASTER (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Entering the first bend, SMALLEYTIME (IRE), unplaced, shifted left-handed whilst racing greenly tightening up CLASH OF THE ASH (IRE), unplaced, which was hampered, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Approximately 2½ furlongs out, TANGO MAN, placed second, lugged slightly right-handed, briefly hampering SHEROOD, placed third, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of TANGO MAN.

Following the race, Trevor Whelan reported that FORCEFUL SPIRIT, unplaced, was slowly away and raced greenly. The Veterinary Officer reported that TANGO MAN, placed second, lost its right-fore shoe.





Race 6 - 9:00pm. THE RACING TV PROFITS BACK TO RACING HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

An enquiry was held to consider interference entering the first bend involving COVERT MISSION (FR), unplaced, ridden by Benoit de la Sayette and CHIFA (IRE), placed third, ridden by Trevor Whelan. Whelan was cautioned for careless riding after angling left-handed to the rail without being fully clear of COVERT MISSION (FR), causing that gelding to be briefly tightened up for racing room.

An enquiry was held to consider interference approximately 2 ½ furlongs out involving FIRST GREYED (IRE), unplaced, ridden by David Probert and SIR MAXI, placed second, ridden by Jack Garritty. Garritty was suspended for 3 days for careless riding as he edged left-handed towards the rail when insufficiently clear of FIRST GREYED (IRE) causing Probert to take a significant check on the gelding.

Following the race, Sam James reported that DANZART (IRE), placed fourth, ran too freely in the early stages.
