Permission was given for JACK THE SAVAGE to wear a red hood and go early to post and for TRAMUNTANA (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

The winner, TRAMUNTANA (IRE), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Southwell on 16 December 2024 where the gelding finished tenth of thirteen runners beaten 29 lengths. Olly Murphy's explanation that the gelding had benefitted from a step up in trip from 2 miles to 2 miles 3 ½ furlongs, was noted. TRAMUNTANA (IRE) was routine tested.
