### Race 1 - 5:15pm.

THE JENNINGSBET EBF RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (for horses in Bands B, C and D) (EBF Restricted Race Qualifier) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for CALYXOH (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

Following the race, Callum Hutchinson reported that REPORTER, placed sixth, was slowly away and ran too freely.

#### Race 2 - 5:45pm. THE JENNINGSBET NEWMARKET BRITISH EBF MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for ARABIAN POET and DOUBLE MEANING to wear a red hood to the start; KNIGHTS GOLD (IRE) wore earplugs which were removed at the start.





# Race 3 - 6:15pm. THE JENNINGSBET HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

The performance of HEY LYLA, which finished sixth, beaten by 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> lengths was considered. The representative of Charlie Johnston could offer no explanation for the filly's performance.

### Race 4 - 6:50pm. THE JENNINGSBET BEST ODDS GUARANTEED HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2)

Permission was given for CLASSIC and WAITING ALL NIGHT to wear a red hood to the start.

An enquiry was held to consider interference inside the final furlong when the winner, WAITING ALL NIGHT, ridden by Neil Callan, interfered with DARKNESS (FR), placed fourth, ridden by Tom Marquand. Callan was cautioned for careless riding as he had allowed his mount to drift left-handed without sufficient correction, causing Marquand to have to take a slight check.

# Race 5 - 7:25pm.

THE JENNINGSBET BUNTINGFORD HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (A Jockey Club Grassroots Middle Distance Series Qualifier)

Permission was given for SILVER GUNN (IRE) and TRIBAL WISDOM (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

# Race 6 - 8:00pm. THE JENNINGSBET BISHOP'S STORTFORD HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for ASINARA to wear a red hood to the start.

An enquiry was held to consider interference approaching the final furlong marker when COURT DRIVE (IRE), placed fifth, ridden by Jonny Peate, interfered with ROYAL MUSKETEER, placed second, ridden by Ray Dawson. Peate was cautioned for careless riding as he had allowed COURT DRIVE (IRE) to drift right-handed without sufficient correction, causing ROYAL MUSKETEER to be carried slightly off its intended line.

Following the race, Joe Leavy reported that MY BOY JACK, placed sixth, stopped quickly and Neil Callan reported that his saddle slipped on HIGH VIOLET (IRE), placed fourth, in the closing stages.
