The Stewards noted that at the second-last hurdle, FLORIDA DREAMS (IRE), placed fifth, was hampered by the fall of FARREN GLORY (IRE), but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

After jumping the second hurdle, CANNOCK PARK, placed third, drifted right-handed carrying FAVOUR AND FORTUNE (IRE), placed second, off its intended line which in turn bumped the winner, JANGO BAIE (FR), but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

The performance of JULY FLOWER (FR), which started second-favourite and was pulled up, was considered. The representative of Mickael Seror's explanation that the filly was never travelling on this occasion was noted. The Veterinary Officer examined JULY FLOWER (FR) post-race and had nothing to report.
