##### **THE RACING TV NOVICES' HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)**

Permission was given for ONNAROLL (FR) to go early to post.

Following the race James Best reported that ONNAROLL (FR), unplaced, ran too free. The Veterinary Officer reported that ALIEN STORM (IRE), placed second, lost it's right hind shoe.

Permission was given for TWINJETS (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race the Veterinary Officer reported that HASTON CLERMONT (FR), unplaced, lost it's right hind shoe.

Permission was given for LIGHT N STRIKE (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Permission was given for JAY BEE WHY (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

**Race 5 - 6:55pm.****THE racingtv.com HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 3)**

The apparent improvement in form of the winner, PASVOLSKY (IRE), compared with its previous run at Wincanton on 5 April 2023 where the gelding finished sixth of seven finishers, beaten by 39 ½ lengths, was considered. Chris Gordons explanation that the gelding benefitted from a set up in trip from 2 miles 4 furlongs to 3 miles on this occasion was noted, and the gelding was routine tested.

The performance of OUR JET (IRE) which started favourite and finished sixth of six finishers, beaten 49 ¾ lengths, was considered. The representative of Dan Skelton reported that the gelding did not stay for 3 miles on the Good to Soft, Soft in places ground on this occasion. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of the gelding, failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Race 6 - 7:25pm.****THE RACING TV CONDITIONAL JOCKEYS' HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4)**

The performance of PAROS (FR), trained by Nicky Henderson, which was pulled up, was considered in light of this being the fourth consecutive occasion that the gelding had failed to finish a race. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of the gelding failed to reveal any abnormalities. The representative of the trainer and the jockey, Luca Morgan were interviewed, and their comments were forwarded to the Head Office of the British Horseracing Authority for further consideration.

Following the race the representative of Sarah Jayne Davies reported that CHASAMAX (IRE), which was pulled up, was never travelling on the ground described as Good to Soft, Soft in places.

**Race 7 - 7:55pm.****THE RACING TV OPEN HUNTERS' STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 5)**

Following the race Miss Alice Stevens reported that GABORIOT (FR), placed third, was never travelling.
