**Race 1 - 2:00pm.****THE UNIBET SIRENIA STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 3)**

Permission was given for HAVANA BLAST to wear a red hood to the start, for IT AIN'T TWO to be mounted in the chute, and for MISS EL FUNDI to be mounted in the chute and wear a red hood to the start.

**Race 2 - 2:35pm.****THE UNIBET SEPTEMBER STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 3)**

Permission was given for LION'S PRIDE, ONESMOOTHOPERATOR (USA), and GOD'S WINDOW to all wear a red hood to the start and for HAMISH to be mounted in the chute and go early to post; the gelding also wore earplugs throughout the preliminaries which were removed upon arrival at the start.

**Race 3 - 3:15pm.****THE UNIBET LONDON MILE SERIES FINAL HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2) (Series Final - Qualified Horses Only)**

Permission was given for KILT (IRE) to go early to post wearing a red hood and for VALKYRIAN (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and go early to post.

Following the race, Tom Marquand reported that KILT (IRE), which started favourite and finished unplaced, ran too free.

**Race 4 - 3:45pm.****THE UNIBET MORE EXTRA PLACE RACES NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)**

Permission was given for TOY SOLDIER (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and wear a red hood to the

start and for CHESNEYS CHARM to wear a red hood to the start.

An enquiry was held to consider interference inside the final ½ furlong involving the winner, FEARLESS FREDDY, ridden by Lewis Edmunds, TILTED KILT (FR), placed second, ridden by Neil Callan, and PATSY SNUGFIT, placed fifth, ridden by Tom Marquand. The interference was found to be accidental in that FEARLESS FREDDY shifted quickly left-handed away from the whip before being corrected by Edmunds, at the same time as TILTED KILT (FR) shifted marginally right-handed causing Marquand to have to take a precautionary check on PATSY SNUGFIT.

**Race 5 - 4:20pm.**

**THE UNIBET LONDON SPRINT SERIES FINAL HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2) (Series Final - Qualified Horses Only)**

Permission was given for both BATAL DUBAI (IRE) and HEATHCLIFF to both wear a red hood to the start.

Following the race, Edward Greatrex reported that FERROUS (IRE), which started favourite and finished fifth, suffered interference on the run to the line.

**Race 6 - 4:55pm.**

**THE UNIBET SUPPORT SAFE GAMBLING HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)**

Permission was given for PIVOTAL TRIGGER, ENRICO CARUSO and NIGHT BREEZE (IRE) to all wear a red hood to the start.

Following the race, Kieran Shoemark reported that ENRICO CARUSO, which started favourite and finished unplaced, was never travelling.

**Race 7 - 5:30pm.**

**THE TRY UNIBET'S IMPROVED BET BUILDER HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) (London Stayers' Series Qualifier)**

Permission was given for both SUPER SUPERJACK and RAKKI to both wear a red hood to the start and COCO ROYALE wore earplugs throughout the race.

Following the race, P. J. McDonald reported that TENERIFE SUNSHINE, unplaced, was slowly away and Edward Greatrex reported that RAKKI, which started second-favourite and finished unplaced, was restless in the stalls.
