Race 1 - 5:27pm .

THE PRISTINE SPECIALIST CLEANING SERVICES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

SIXTY PLUS (IRE), trained by James Owen, won the previous day, 24 July, at Thirsk. Having been examined by the Veterinary Officer, the gelding was deemed fit to race.

Race 2 - 6:00pm .

THE PRISTINE LANDSCAPING & GARDEN MAINTENANCE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for HOMELAND to go early to post and for CELTIC SPIRIT to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Jack Callan reported that HOMELAND, placed third, hung badly right-handed causing him to correct the gelding on several occasions in the final furlong. Nicola Currie reported that LEIA ANTILLES (IRE), unplaced, stopped quickly. The Veterinary Officer examined the filly post-race and had nothing to report.

Race 3 - 6:30pm .

THE PRISTINE HOMES RESTRICTED MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 5) (for horses in Band D) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for LAST DANDELION to be mounted in the chute and for MYSTIC RALLISTIC to wear a red hood to post.

The Starter reported that YANKEEDOODLEDANDY refused to enter the stalls and was withdrawn at 6.31pm. J.S. Moore was informed that the filly could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

Approximately four furlongs out, ROBERTS LEGACY, unplaced, stepped left-handed at the same the winner, SPIRIT OF LYRA (IRE), shifted marginally right-handed, causing the rider of ROBERTS LEGACY to take a check. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Race 4 - 7:00pm .

THE RJB AGRI EBF NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for CASH FLOW BOY, CATCHING DREAMS and IT DUNT MARRA to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, the representative of Richard Hughes reported that IT'S A GINGER THING (IRE), unplaced, was unsuited by the going which was officially described as Good to Firm and would prefer a easier surface.

Race 5 - 7:30pm .

THE INDIGO LIFTS GROUP FILLIES' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

The winner, DUSKAURA (IRE) appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Nottingham on 4 July 2026, where the filly finished last of seven runners, beaten by 12 ½ lengths. It was noted that Tony Carroll could offer no explanation for DUSKAURA (IRE) improved form on this occasion. The filly was routine tested.

Race 6 - 8:00pm .

THE ELMSTONE FIRE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for ADALIDA to be mounted in the chute and for SIR ALFIE (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Leaving the stalls, SIR ALFIE (IRE), placed fourth, jumped quickly right-handed, causing ADALIDA, placed second, to become short of room. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Approximately four furlongs out, the winner, DEBRIEF, shifted marginally right-handed, causing GOLDWORK, placed third, to become short of room and taken off heels. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and had not improved the placing of DEBRIEF.

Race 7 - 8:30pm .

THE SMITH & WESTERN SHOWDOWN HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)



Permission was given for DIOMED DUKE to wear a red hood to post and for MIRACLEOFTHEANDES (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Joe Leavy reported that OUR PLANET (IRE), unplaced, hung left-handed under pressure.
