Permission was given for KINGS CHAMPION (FR) and URBLEREAGH (FR) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Jack Andrews reported that A LAW TO HIMSELF (IRE), unplaced, hung left-handed; and Theo Gillard reported that URBLEREAGH (FR), unplaced, jumped and hung left-handed throughout.

Race 2 - 12:40pm .

THE BOOK BOXING DAY AT THE RACES 'NATIONAL HUNT' MAIDEN HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4) (GBB

RACE)

Permission was given for WINGS ON WHEELS (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Olly Murphy was cautioned as KEFIR D'OUDAIRIES (FR) had arrived in the Parade Ring with an undeclared tongue strap which was removed from the gelding before going down to the start.

The performance of WHITE RIOT (FR), which was pulled up, was considered. Fergal O'Brien's explanation that WHITE RIOT (FR) made a respiratory noise, was noted. The Veterinary Officer examined WHITE RIOT (FR) during routine testing, confirmed the respiratory noise and further reported that the gelding had bled from the nose.
