Race 1 - 4:55pm .

THE UNIBET SUPPORTING SAFER GAMBLING NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (DIV I) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for both LANDSLIDE and STORMY MUSIC to wear red hoods to post.

Oliver Cole was fined £200 for failing to notify the Racing Calendar Office prior to declarations that LANDSLIDE had been gelded, this being his first breach within the previous 12 months.

The Starter reported that SCREEN ACTOR (USA) refused to enter the stalls and was withdrawn at 4.55pm. Michael Attwater was informed that the gelding could not run until the day after passing a stalls test. As it was the second occasion within the previous 12 months that SCREEN ACTOR (USA) had been reported, a further report within the same period would mean the gelding would be prevented from having a stalls test for 6 months.

The Starter reported that GIFT BOX refused to enter stalls and was withdrawn at 4.58pm. Laura Mongan was informed that the filly could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

The Starter had reported that the representative of Laura Mongan had used abusive language towards an official. Mongan was fined £200.

Shortly after the start, a free running KHALEEJY (IRE), placed second, shifted left-handed, making contact with STORMY MUSIC, unplaced, and then shifted quickly back towards the rail, causing a free running VEIL OF CLOUDS, unplaced, to become briefly crowded for room, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of KHALEEJY (IRE).

Following the race, Tom Kiely-Marshall reported that KHALEEJY (IRE), placed second, hung left-handed in the straight. Luke Morris reported that LANDSLIDE, unplaced, hung left-handed.

Race 2 - 5:33pm .

THE UNIBET SUPPORTING SAFER GAMBLING NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (DIV II) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for CORTADO GIRL to go early to post and for LADY FIZZ to wear a red hood to post.

Robert Havlin, the rider of YAZOO, was unseated shortly after leaving the stalls. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no other horse or rider was involved and was caused by the gelding ducking sharply right-handed and unseating Havlin.

Race 3 - 6:03pm .

THE BET £20 GET £20 WITH UNIBET NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for GRACEFUL GEORGE (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

The winner, BIN WAARY (IRE), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Leicester, on 13 June 2026, where the colt finished eighth of nine runners, beaten by 22¼ lengths. Charlie Johnston's explanation that BIN WAARY (IRE) possibly had benefited from a return to Kempton Park, where the colt had previously performed well on his debut was noted. BIN WAARY (IRE) was routine tested.

The performance of INDIAN LAND, which finished seventh of eight runners, beaten by 10 lengths, was considered. It was noted that the representative of Ralph Beckett could offer no explanation for the colt's performance. The Veterinary Officer examined INDIAN LAND post-race and had nothing to report.

Following the race, Paddy Bradley reported that GRACEFUL GEORGE (IRE), unplaced, jumped badly left-handed leaving the stalls and the gelding was slowly away as a result. Olivia Tubb reported that

MAGICAL LIFE, placed fifth, hung badly left-handed off the bend and in the home straight.

Race 4 - 6:33pm .

**THE UNIBET MORE EXTRA PLACE RACES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) (London Mile Series Qualifier)
(DIV I)**

Permission was given for BLUE PRINCE (IRE) to go early to post wearing a red hood and for both MAXIMISING (IRE) and GRIZEDALE to wear red hoods to post.

Race 5 - 7:08pm .

**THE UNIBET MORE EXTRA PLACE RACES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) (London Mile Series Qualifier)
(DIV II)**

Permission was given for both BREAKDANCER (IRE) and ATLANTIS BLUE to wear red hoods to post.

Following the race, Harry Davies reported that NOTIMEFORCHITCHAT (IRE), which was pulled up, stopped quickly, the Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race and had nothing to report.

Race 6 - 7:43pm .

THE UNIBET 40,000+ LIVE STREAMED EVENTS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3) (GBBPLUS RACE)

Race 7 - 8:17pm .

THE TRY UNIBET'S NEW IMPROVED ACCA BOOSTS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (London Sprint Series Qualifier)

Permission was given for THE LOST SOCK (IRE) to go early to post wearing a red hood, and for TRINCULO, AIGEAS (FR) and NIGHT SHINING (IRE) to all wear red hoods to post.

Leaving the stalls, SHAHIK, unplaced, jumped right-handed, bumping and unbalancing OUR GUY (IRE), unplaced, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Approaching one furlong out, TRINCULO, placed fifth, shifted quickly left-handed, whilst the rider was pulling his stick through, moving EVENEPOEL (IRE), placed third, slightly off its intended line, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Race 8 - 8:53pm .

THE TRY UNIBET'S NEW SMARTVIEW RACECARDS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (London Sprint Series Qualifier)

Permission was given for INVINCIBLE SPEED (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

An enquiry was held to consider the placings in this race after two incidents of interference on the run to the line, involving the winner, INITIAL BLUE (IRE), ridden by Rossa Ryan, SERENITY DREAM (IRE), placed second, ridden by Billy Loughnane and MASSIMO BLUE, placed third, ridden by Neil Callan. The Stewards considered that both incidents of interference were accidental. The first incident, one



furlong out, MASSIMO BLUE edged slightly right-handed making contact with INITIAL BLUE (IRE), which resulted in MASSIMO BLUE being shifted off his intended line, making slight contact with SERENITY DREAM (IRE). In the second incident, INITIAL BLUE (IRE) edged slightly left-handed giving a light brush to MASSIMO BLUE, who shifted left-handed, giving a slight bump to SERENITY DREAM (IRE) who's quarters were turned. The Stewards considered that it had not improved INITIAL BLUE (IRE)'s placing as despite SERENITY DREAM (IRE)'s quarters being turned there appeared to be no visible loss of momentum, to be beaten by distance of a short head at the line.
