THE HORIZON GROUP MAIDEN HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for LUCKIE DEVIL (IRE) and SCRIBABIN (FR) to wear a red hood to post.

The Veterinary Officer reported that MOON REIGN, trained by Iain Jardine, appeared to show evidence of possible administration of a substance, with a swelling present in the region of the left jugular vein. The Trainer's representative, an EWIO and the Veterinary Officer were interviewed. Jardine's representative explained that the gelding had been administered with an antibiotic the previous day, 1 July 2026, which was verified by the home Veterinary Surgeon. Being satisfied that MOON REIGN had received only normal food and water by mouth on the day of racing, the Stewards allowed the horse to run and ordered MOON REIGN to be routine tested post-race.

Following the race, Nathan Moscrop reported that DOTTIE'S PROMISE, unplaced, jumped novicey. Murray Dodd reported that MOON REIGN, unplaced, made a mistake when tiring at the second last hurdle.
