Going: GOOD TO FIRM

Rail: The inside line of the straight mile chute (a 5m width where the vehicles drive) has been dolled off from the 1m start down to just before the 5f start. Additionally, we'll be gradually doling off part of the inside line in the home straight from around the 4f pole down to the just after the 2f pole, where the dolled out rail will be just under 3m off the usual inside rail, after which it will cutaway leaving the normal width down to the finish line.

Stalls: 5F & 6F - Stands Rail 7F & 1M - Centre 1m 2F & 1m 6F - Inside Rail

Race 1 - 2:20pm .**THE racingtv.com EBF RESTRICTED MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 4) (for horses in Bands B, C and D) (EBF Restricted Race Qualifier) (GBB RACE)**

Permission was given for both FREEDOM FLAME (IRE) and LIVEADREAM to wear a red hood to the start.

Following the race, Oisín McSweeney reported that KHAZAMH (IRE), unplaced, jumped right-handed from the stalls.

Race 2 - 2:50pm .**THE WATCH IRISH RACING ON RACING TV RESTRICTED MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 4) (for horses in Bands A, B, C and D) (GBB RACE)**

Permission was given for both CAPE FEAR and HOSEKI (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

Race 3 - 3:20pm .**THE CELEBRATE THE LIFE OF JOE NEWTON HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)**

Race 4 - 3:50pm .**THE JOIN RACING TV NOW HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)**

Permission was given for ANDESITE to go early wearing a red hood to the start; for CLASSIC ENCOUNTER (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start; for ELIGIBLE (IRE) to go early to the start.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that NYMAN (IRE), unplaced, had bled from the nose.

Race 5 - 4:20pm .**THE RACING TV PROFITS RETURNED TO RACING HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)**

On approaching the line LONG SHOT, placed fourth, edged right-handed causing HUNTERIAN (IRE), placed third, to be moved slightly off its intended line which resulted in RESDEV TIME, unplaced, being short of room and its rider having to take a check. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, Jason Hart reported that POSITIVE THOUGHTS (IRE), unplaced, was never travelling

Race 6 - 4:50pm .**THE WATCH RACING TV IN STUNNING HD FILLIES' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)**

Permission was given for AURORA'S DOUBLESIX (IRE) to go early wearing a red hood to the start.

Nigel Tinkler had obtained prior permission from the BHA to run JEANY MAY partially shod.

Approximately 1 ½ furlongs out JAMIE'S CHOICE, placed third, shifted quickly left-handed at the same time as AUNTIE JO, placed second, improved its position, which caused that filly to be carried left-handed, resulting in DORALEE, unplaced, and LADY BOUQUET, unplaced, both being moved slightly off their intended lines. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

The winner, CROCUS TIME (IRE), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run on 16 May 2026 at Thirsk where the filly finished tenth of seventeen runners beaten by 10 ½ lengths. The explanation given by Ron Barr that filly appeared to have stripped fitter from her previous run, which followed a 227 days break, was noted. CROCUS TIME (IRE) was routine tested.

Race 7 - 5:23pm .**THE WATCH RACE REPLAYS ON RACING TV AMATEUR JOCKEYS' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)**

Permission was given for ANDALPROFIT (IRE) to go early wearing a red hood to the start; for EVOLUIR (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

The winner, ANDALPROFIT (IRE), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run on 16 May 2026 at Thirsk where the gelding finished eighth of seventeen runners beaten by 9 lengths. The explanation given by representative of Nigel Tinkler that ANDALPROFIT (IRE) may have appreciated not being crowded by other runners on this occasion, was noted.
