Race 1 - 12:25pm .

THE RACING TV FREE TRIAL NOW EBF NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for GANTHORPE, LAMLASH BAY and SIMMY'S LEGACY to wear a red hood to post.

KEEP AN EYE IN IT unseated David Nolan on the way to the start. Having been checked by the Doctor at the start, Nolan was deemed fit to ride.

Following the race, Billy Garritty reported that GANTHORPE, unplaced, ran green and hung right-handed throughout.

Race 2 - 12:55pm .

THE WEAR YOUR POPPY WITH PRIDE NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for RESDEV TIME to wear a red hood to post.

Race 3 - 1:25pm .

THE BOWEL CANCER SCREENING PROGRAMME SAVES LIVES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for STREAK LIGHTNING (IRE) to go early to post and for EXPOSAY to go early to post wearing a red hood.

Jake Dickson the rider of ENOLA GREY (IRE), drawn 12, was slow to remove the blindfold. Dickson's explanation that the blindfold became stuck on the mares bridle and took two attempts to remove it,

was noted.

An enquiry was held to consider the unruly behaviour of STREAK LIGHTNING (IRE) which had fly leapt leaving the stalls and unseated its rider. The representative of Ruth Carr was interviewed and shown recordings of the incident. As the gelding had also fly leapt and unseated its rider at Newcastle on 27 October 2025. Carr's representative was informed that any future similar behaviour from STREAK LIGHTNING (IRE) may result in the horse being reported to the Head Office of the British Horseracing Authority.

Following the race, Joanna Mason reported that LOOK BACK SMILING (IRE), unplaced, was never travelling. Bryan Smart reported that JAMAICAN STORM, unplaced, ran too free.

THE CAROL SIMPSON LEGACY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (DIV I)

Permission was given for CROCODILE POWER (IRE) to go early to post; for ANDALPROFIT (IRE) to go early to post wearing a red hood and for DILIGENT HENRY to wear a red hood to post.

SIBYL CHARM (IRE) wore earplugs throughout the race.

The winner, ANDALPROFIT (IRE), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Southwell on 16 October 2025, where the gelding finished ninth of eleven, beaten 7¼ lengths. It was noted that Nigel Tinkler could offer no explanation for the gelding's improved form on this occasion. ANADALPROFIT (IRE) was routine tested.

Following the race Dale Swift reported that CROCODILE POWER (IRE), unplaced, was denied a clear run. Billy Garritty reported that WHAT WHAT WHAT, unplaced, stumbled leaving the stalls. Barry McHugh reported that MADAME PLAINTIFF (IRE), unplaced, was slowly away.

Race 7 - 3:27pm .

THE CAROL SIMPSON LEGACY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (DIV II)

Permission was given for MISSMIMI to be mounted in the chute and to go early to post; for GISELLES IZZY (IRE) to go early to post and for BRAVE BOB to wear a red hood to post.

Inside the final ½ furlong, the winner MISSMIMI, lugged quickly right-handed giving a bump to CHIEF OF STATE (IRE), placed third, which in turn gave a slight nudge to GLENDOWN (IRE), placed second. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had

not improved the placing of MISSMIMI.

Following the race, Cara Tuke reported that GISELLES IZZY (IRE), unplaced, suffered interference leaving the stalls.

Race 8 - 3:57pm .

THE THANKS AND SEE YOU NEXT SEASON APPRENTICE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Leaving the stalls, HARRY WHODEANIE, unplaced, jumped left-handed, causing CROWNTHORPE, placed third, to become short of room and peck. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

½ a furlong out, CROWNTHORPE, placed third, hung left-handed, causing LITTLE TED, unplaced, to become tight for room and its rider having to take a precautionary check against the rail. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of CROWNTHORPE.

Following the race, Warren Fentiman reported that LITTLE TED, unplaced, suffered interference ½ a furlong out.
