Race 1 - 2:14pm .

THE AL BASTI EQUIWORLD, DUBAI APPRENTICE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (Part of Racing Excellence - whips to be carried but not used)

Approaching final furlong, CRECIENTE, placed fourth, hung left-handed despite the best efforts of its rider, taking AHEAD OF FASHION, placed fifth, slightly off its intended racing line, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of CRECIENTE.

Following the race, Kyle McHugh reported that CRECIENTE, placed fourth, hung left-handed.

Race 2 - 2:44pm .

THE PETER LAWRENCE MEMORIAL HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for both BLUE PRINCE (IRE) and SPIRIT OF BREEZE (IRE) to go early to the start and to wear a red hood to post, for ARARAT (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and to wear a red hood to post and for LAND OF MAGIC to be mounted in the chute. THE DRAGON KING (IRE) wore earplugs throughout.

Race 3 - 3:14pm .

THE R HANNON RACING SUPPORTS THE SAVITRI WANNEY CHARITY EBF NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 3) (GBB RACE)

Approximately 2 furlongs out, WEEKEND ROAR (IRE), placed third, stepped quickly left-handed causing the rider of SAKOWIN (IRE), unplaced, to steady for several strides, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of WEEKEND ROAR (IRE).

Following the race, Millie Wonnacott reported that TEXAS CROWN, unplaced, hung left-handed.

Race 4 - 3:47pm .

THE iwrightsongs.com FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 3) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for ASSET (GER), WILD VIOLET (FR) and BRUNHILDE (IRE) to each wear a red hood to post.

Inside the final furlong, Hector Crouch, the rider of WILD VIOLET (FR), struck BRUNHILDE (IRE), placed second, once over the nose with the whip, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was considered to be accidental.

Race 5 - 4:22pm .

THE H S LESTER MEMORIAL CHALLENGE CUP "CONFINED" HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (horses which have not won a race since 2025 Flat Turf Season)

Permission was given for PRIMO LARA (IRE), HUGGABLE, MIGHTY QUIET, SUHUB and REDBUD SIXTEEN (IRE) to each wear a red hood to post.

Race 6 - 4:57pm .

THE SHIPSEYS MARQUEES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for THE HARE RAIL (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and to go early to post.

Approximately 2 furlongs out, SPIRIT OF THE BAY (IRE), placed fourth, hung right-handed despite the best efforts of its rider, which resulted in SANT ALESSIO (IRE), unplaced, being moved onto the weakening DARVEL (IRE), unplaced, which became tight for room, giving a slight bump to RATING (IRE) when becoming short of room between runners, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of SPIRIT OF THE BAY (IRE).

Following the race, Taylor Fisher reported that SANT ALESSIO (IRE), unplaced, hung right-handed and William Cox reported that SPIRIT OF THE BAY (IRE), placed fourth, also hung right-handed.
