Race 1 - 1:32pm .

THE DOWNLOAD THE BETMGM APP HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for LOBLOLLY (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 2 - 2:05pm .

THE BETMGM FILLIES' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for DISTANT SHORE to go early to post and for CITY QUEEN (IRE) and HATOUR (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 3 - 2:42pm .

THE BETMGM SCURRY STAKES (CLASS 1) (Listed Race)

Permission was given for WORDS OF TRUTH, OUR CODY (IRE), PALMEIRA and MILITARY CODE to wear a red hood to post.

Approximately one furlong out, LADY YOUMZAIN (IRE), placed second, shifted slightly left-handed at the same time as ARGENTINE TANGO, placed sixth, shifted slightly right-handed causing OUR CODY (IRE), placed fourth, to become short of room when going for a legitimate gap. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Race 4 - 3:17pm .

THE READ MEG NICHOLLS' BLOG AT betmgm.co.uk HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2)

Permission was given for RAAMMEE to go early to post and for SEAN (GER) and TILTED KILT (FR) to wear a red hood to post. HIGH DEGREE wore earplugs which were removed at the start.

Leaving the stalls, COGITATE (IRE), placed fifth, jumped sharply left-handed causing the rider of CASH (IRE), unplaced, to take a slight check, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and it had not improved the placing of COGITATE (IRE).

Race 5 - 3:55pm .

THE BET £10 GET £40 WITH BETMGM HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for ARCHER ROYAL (IRE) and WEZZEER (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and for IRONWILL (IRE) to be mounted on the chute. CROWN OFFICE wore earplugs throughout the race.

Leaving the stalls, CROWN OFFICE, placed fourth, jumped left-handed at the same time as CASHBOX, unplaced, jumped right-handed causing ARCHER ROYAL (IRE), unplaced, and SOVEREIGN OCEAN (IRE), placed sixth, to become short of room. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, Charles Bishop reported that SPIRIT OF SAXONY (IRE), placed second, was denied a clear run approximately one furlong out and Saffie Osborne reported that MALACHY'S WISH, unplaced, hung badly right-handed.

Race 6 - 4:32pm .

THE DARLEY BRITISH EBF MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 2) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for TURTY TREE (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 7 - 5:07pm .

THE GAMBLE RESPONSIBLY AT BETMGM HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBBPLUS RACE)

Permission was given for TROJAN STORM to wear a red hood to post.

Approximately 1 ½ furlongs out, PYLEATES lugged quickly right-handed before being corrected by the rider, giving a bump to PERCY SHELLEY, unplaced. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.
