**THE PETER WATSON MEMORIAL NOVICES' LIMITED HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 3) (GBB RACE)**

### Race 2 - 6:12pm .

**THE FOR SOLDIERS FOR LIFE NOVICES' HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)**

Permission was given for both ETERNAL ANGEL (FR) and L'AMALRIC (FR) to wear a red hood to the start.

Following the race, Tabitha Worsley reported that PRETTY DARN QUICK, which was pulled up, stopped quickly.

### Race 3 - 6:42pm .

**THE GROUNDSHORE CUP NOVICES' LIMITED HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 5)**

Permission was given for both KAYLA'S FRIEND (IRE) and SAINT VIC (FR) to wear a red hood to the start.

BALLYNOE BOY (IRE) wore earplugs throughout the race.

An enquiry was held to consider interference after the third last hurdle involving FANE COURT (IRE), placed fourth, ridden by Tom Bellamy; BABYCHINO (IRE), placed third, ridden by Ms Sophie Carter and NO RISK TODAY (FR), unplaced, ridden by Jack Hogan. Being a 7lb claiming amateur Ms Carter was accompanied in the enquiry by a senior rider. Ms Carter was suspended for 2 days for careless riding, on dates which will be notified to her by the Head Office of the British Horseracing Authority, as she made a misjudgment when moving right-handed into a clearing, taking NO RISK TODAY (FR) off its intended line onto FANE COURT (IRE), who as a result was carried off its intended line.

Shortly after turning into the home straight the weakening SAINT VIC (FR), unplaced, became short of room between MYA DU CLOS (FR), placed second, and BALLYNOE BOY (IRE), unplaced, as they improved their position on either side of 10. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of MYA DU CLOS (FR).

#### **Race 4 - 7:12pm .**

##### **THE #MOOGANGETSKNIGHTED NOVICES' HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 5)**

Permission was given for TWP STORI to wear a red hood to the start.

The raceday privilege request for TWP STORI, trained by Samuel Drinkwater, to wear a red hood to post was late being submitted. Drinkwater was warned as to his responsibility to ensure that all raceday privilege requests are submitted by 1pm on the day before racing.

CREST OF VALOUR, trained by Anthony Honeyball, ran without its declared tongue strap as it was unable to be fitted. Anthony Honeyball's representative felt that running without it did not affect the gelding's performance.

After an initial false start, the start was effected successfully on the second attempt. However, having reviewed recordings of the false start, the Starters were satisfied that no riders should be reported for contravening the starting procedures.

#### **Race 5 - 7:42pm .**

##### **THE 4 OAKS GROUP HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 4) (ARC Summer Chase Series Qualifier) (GBB RACE)**

Permission was given for MARY (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

Turning into the home straight the winner, MIGHTY FLEUR had lost its right cheek-piece. However the cheek-piece was unable to be located therefore unable to be inspected, no further action was taken.

#### **Race 6 - 8:17pm .**

##### **THE NOBLE MINDS COUNSELLING SERVICES MARES' HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 5)**

Permission was given for LORO WHITE to wear a red hood to the start.



**Race 7 - 8:53pm .**

**THE QUINNBET HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4)**

BELVEDERE BLAST (IRE) was kicked at the start by another runner. Having been checked by the Veterinary Surgeon, the gelding was deemed fit to race.
