Race 1 - 5:05pm .
THE JUDDMONTE EBF RESTRICTED MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 2) (for horses in Band D) (EBF Restricted Race Qualifier) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for TOP COTE (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Joe Leavy reported that BETTER NATURE, unplaced, hung right-handed under pressure; Paddy Bradley reported that GRACEFUL GEORGE (IRE), unplaced, hung left-handed inside the final two furlongs and Dylan Hogan reported that TERRY O, placed fifth, was denied a clear run on multiple occasions inside the final 1½ furlongs.

Race 2 - 5:40pm .
THE FITZDARES SPRINT SERIES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2) (Fitzdares Windsor Sprint Series Qualifier)

Permission was given for ADRESTIA and RHYTHM N HOOVES to wear a red hood to post; for REGAL ENVOY (IRE) and DEMOCRACY DILEMMA (IRE) to go early, wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that MARTY HOPKIRK (IRE), placed fourth, lost its right hind shoe.

Race 3 - 6:10pm .**THE TATTERSALLS £40,000 EBF MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 2) (GBB RACE)**

Permission was given for WITHTEARSINMYEYES (IRE) to wear a red hood to post. CHIMES OF THUNDER (GER) wore ear plugs which were removed at the start.

Richard Hannon had obtained prior permission from the BHA to run TAHALEL (IRE) partially shod.

Following the race, Callum Hutchinson reported that TRELISSICK, unplaced, stumbled leaving the stalls.

Race 4 - 6:40pm .**THE TRACK RADIO ON DIGITAL & DAB HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)**

Permission was given for MAHARAJAS EXPRESS and SARAFINA MSHAIRI to wear a red hood to post; for JAX EDGE and GENERAL ASSEMBLY (IRE) to go early, wear a red hood to post and for THE FLYING SEAGULL (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and be mounted in the chute.

Race 5 - 7:10pm .**THE FITZDARES TELEPHONE & TEXT BETTING HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)**

Permission was given for ANY WHICH WAY to wear a red hood to post.

Race 6 - 7:40pm .**THE FIND US AT fitzdares.com HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBBPLUS RACE)**

Permission was given for WISPER (IRE), SON OF MAN (IRE) and DUE TO HENRY to wear a red hood to post.

Race 7 - 8:10pm .**THE FREE RACE REPLAYS ON attheraces.com HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)**

Permission was given for YACHTSMAN to wear a red hood to post.

NZURI unseated George Bass on the way to post. Having been examined by the Doctor and the Veterinary Surgeon, both NZURI and George Bass were deemed fit to race.

Approximately two and a half furlongs out, STOLEN, unplaced, stepped left-handed at the same time as ARVANA BELLE (IRE), unplaced, edged right-handed, causing them to come together. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

One and a half furlongs out, MARRA DONNA (IRE), placed fifth, shifted left-handed before being corrected, taking CORNICHE GIRL (IRE), placed fourth, marginally off its intended line, which resulted in CHELIO, unplaced, and ROSIEISME DARLING, placed third, being taken off their intended lines. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of MARRA DONNA (IRE).



Following the race, Charles Bishop reported that STOLEN, unplaced, hung left-handed; Joe Leavy reported that ZOULETTE (IRE), unplaced, was slowly away and Tom Marquand reported that CHELIO, unplaced, was denied a clear run on several occasions inside the final furlong.
