Race 1 - 2:12pm .

THE MIDNITE A NEXT GENERATION BETTING APP AMATEUR JOCKEYS' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for MOLLY VALENTINE (IRE) to go early to post and be mounted in the chute. Permission was also given for ZAMBEZI MAGIC to go early to post and be mounted in the chute and for VOLTO DI MEDUSA (IRE) to be mounted in the chute.

An enquiry was held to consider interference rounding the home turn, involving the winner, LATIN (IRE), ridden by Mr Henry Callan and BRONTE BEACH (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Miss Brodie Hampson. Miss Aaliyah Bowers-Carter, the rider of PLEASANT MAN, placed second, was also interviewed but found not to be involved in the incident. The interference was found to be accidental as when BRONTE BEACH (IRE) was manoeuvred around ONE MILLION DREAMS (FR), unplaced, which was falling back through the field, Miss Hampson had to steady BRONTE BEACH (IRE) when LATIN (IRE) moved marginally left-handed.

Following the race, Miss Jessica Llewellyn reported that ZAMBEZI MAGIC, unplaced, stumbled leaving the stalls.

Race 2 - 2:42pm .

THE BET £10 GET £40 WITH BETMGM HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

An enquiry was held to consider the placings in this race after interference inside the final ½ furlong, involving WISSETANCK (IRE), placed third, ridden by Finley Marsh and SOLAR INVINCIBLE (IRE), placed fourth, ridden by Billy Loughnane. Kieran O'Neill, the rider of the winner, MISTER MOET (IRE) was interviewed but found not to be involved in the incident. The Stewards considered that the interference had not improved WISSETANCK (IRE)'s placing as although Loughnane had to steady his mount for a number of strides before the line, WISSETANCK (IRE) always appeared to be holding SOLAR INVINCIBLE (IRE) with the margin being ½ length, the Stewards could not be satisfied that SOLAR INVINCIBLE (IRE) would've finished in front of WISSETANCK (IRE) with an uninterrupted run to the line and therefore ordered the placings to remain unaltered. Marsh was suspended for 2 days for

careless riding as he allowed his mount to drift left-handed with his whip in the incorrect hand causing Loughnane to take a check.

Race 3 - 3:12pm .

THE DAILY PROFIT BOOSTS AT betmgm.co.uk HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for SERGEANT PEP (IRE) to go early to post.

Race 4 - 3:42pm .

THE READ MEG NICHOLLS' BLOG AT betmgm.co.uk HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for YACHTSMAN to wear a red hood to post.

Entering the first bend, BECAUSE WE CAN (IRE), unplaced, steadied off the heels of PRETTY DANIELLE (IRE), placed third, resulting in the rider of a free running MY SHAGAF (IRE), unplaced, having to take a check off heels, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, Connor Planas reported that MY SHAGAF (IRE), unplaced, ran too free.

Race 5 - 4:12pm .

THE BETMGM SUPPORTS SAFER GAMBLING RESTRICTED MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 5) (for horses in Bands B, C and D) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for both STELLA LUCENTE (IRE) and THUNDERHOOF to wear a red hood to post.

Race 6 - 4:42pm .

THE ALWAYS GAMBLE RESPONSIBLY AT BETMGM HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for both SECRET ROAD (IRE) and FOOLS RUSH IN (IRE) to go early to post. Permission was also given for COSI BEAR (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and for NO KNEE NEVER (IRE) to be mounted in the chute.

Following the race, William Carson reported that ROYAL JET, unplaced, was slowly away; Taryn Langley reported that FOOLS RUSH IN (IRE), unplaced, jumped awkwardly from the stalls and Tyrese Cameron reported that ALWAYS FEARLESS (IRE), unplaced, never travelled.

Race 7 - 5:17pm .

THE MAKE THE MOVE TO MIDNITE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for THE CORPORATE GUY (IRE) to go early to post and be mounted in the chute.

Following the race, Hector Crouch reported that THE CORPORATE GUY (IRE), unplaced, reared as the stalls opened and Kieren Fox reported that FORNIDO, placed fourth, ran too free.
