### **Race 1 - 1:47pm .**

#### **THE DOWNLOAD THE RACEDAYREADY APP AMATEUR JOCKEYS' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)**

Permission was given for both DAPPER GEE GEE and ASIAN JOURNEY (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start and for EY UP ITS JAZZ, PORT LOUIS (IRE), and AMAYSMONT to go early to post.

Following the race, Mr Simon Walker reported that KING OF YORK (IRE), unplaced, ran too free in the early stages of the race and weakened quickly from 2 furlongs out.

### **Race 2 - 2:20pm .**

#### **THE STONEHOUSE TRAVEL AGENTS BARNSELEY NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)**

Permission was given for HALLA BIL ZAIN (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and go early to post wearing a red hood.

Approaching the final furlong, FIREWALKER, unplaced, hung quickly left-handed interfering with KING OF EARTH, placed second, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Inside the final furlong, the winner, LANGSTONE, hung sharply left-handed interfering with I'M JUST KEN, unplaced, which in turn interfered with SIMON PIERRE (FR), unplaced, and VIPER, unplaced, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of LANGSTONE.

Approaching the line, the winner, LANGSTONE, continued to hang left-handed interfering with NAVAL LIGHT, placed third, whose rider had to take a check, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of LANGSTONE.

**Race 3 - 2:55pm .****THE WILLIAM HILL EPIC BOOSTS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) (DIV I)**

Permission was given for UNDER THE TWILIGHT to wear a red hood to the start, for GOLDEN STRIKE (IRE) to go early to post wearing a red hood and for both ALFA WHITEBURD (IRE) and VICTORY SOUND (IRE) to go early to post.

Following the race, Oisín Orr reported that GOLDEN STRIKE (IRE), which started second-favourite and finished unplaced, was restless in the stalls and the Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race during routine testing and had nothing to report. Sean Kirrane reported that QUEST FOR FUN, unplaced, was denied a clear run approaching 1 furlong out, David Egan reported that NAKAAHA, unplaced, hung right-handed, and Lewis Chalkley reported that BEAUTY CHOICE, unplaced, hung left-handed.

**Race 4 - 3:30pm .****THE WILLIAM HILL EPIC BOOSTS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) (DIV II)**

Permission was given for EPICTETUS (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

Following the race, Lewis Edmunds reported that SHAZANI (FR), which started favourite and finished unplaced, stopped quickly and the Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race and had nothing to report.

**Race 5 - 4:05pm .****THE WILLIAM HILL NRMB ON THE GRAND NATIONAL HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3) (GBBPLUS RACE)**

Permission was given for HARVEY (FR) to go early to post and for SPIORADALTA to wear a red hood to the start.

**Race 6 - 4:40pm .****THE WILLIAM HILL BEST ODDS GUARANTEED HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)**

Inside the final ½ furlong, SIAM RUBY (IRE), placed second, hung left-handed leaving MORBEH, placed fourth, short of room causing it's rider to have to take a check momentarily, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of SIAM RUBY (IRE).

Following the race, Cieren Fallon reported that MORBEH, which started second-favourite and finished fourth, suffered interference inside the final ½ furlong.

**Race 7 - 5:15pm .****THE WILLIAM HILL EACH WAY EXTRA HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)**

Permission was given for both KORKER (IRE) and PHYSIQUE (IRE) to go early to post and for JUNGLE DRUMS (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and go early to post wearing a red hood.

Following the race, Cian Horgan reported that LORD BERTIE (FR), unplaced, was denied a clear run



between the 2-furlong and final furlong marker.

**Race 8 - 5:50pm .**

**THE WILLIAM HILL PRICE BOOSTS EVERY DAY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)**

Permission was given for SPOOF to go early to post, for THUNDER STAR, J STREET and THE FIXER (IRE) to all wear a red hood to the start and for JUAN LES PINS to be mounted in the chute and go early to post wearing a red hood.

Following the race, Sam James reported that J STREET, unplaced, was denied a clear run from the 2-furlong marker to the final furlong marker. Jason Hart reported that OUR ABSENT FRIENDS (IRE), which started second-favourite and finished unplaced, weakened quickly and the Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race during routine testing and had nothing to report.
