**Race 1 - 5:34pm .****THE DOWNLOAD THE RACEDAY READY APP HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)**

Permission was given for WESTLAIN (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and go early to post, wearing a red hood; and for DIVOT and MOTABA AH (IRE) to both wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, William Carver reported that RAY GUN (USA), unplaced, stopped quickly; the Veterinary Officer examined RAY GUN (USA) post-race and had nothing to report; the Veterinary Officer reported that PHAEDRA, placed fifth, had been struck into on its left-hind.

Permission was given for CROESO CYMRAEG to be mounted in the chute, go early and be led to post, wearing a red hood; For SALAMANCA CITY (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and wear a red hood to post; and for AFLOAT and LORDSBRIDGE BLU to both wear a red hood to post.

The winner CROESO CYMRAEG, appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Lingfield Park on 10 May 2025, where the gelding finished ninth of nine, beaten by 11 ¼ lengths on going officially described as Good to Firm, Good in places. James Evans representative's explanation that CROESO CYMRAEG appreciated the slower conditions on this occasion, which officially changed to Soft, Heavy in places following the race, was noted. CROESO CYMRAEG was routine tested.
