Race 1 - 1:20pm .
THE FRASERS PLUS DESIGNER OUTLET SWINDON APPRENTICE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (Bath Summer Stayers' Series Qualifier)

An enquiry was held to consider interference approximately one furlong after the start involving, EVEREST, placed second, ridden by Jude Fernandes and MIND HUNTER, unplaced, ridden by Shay Farmer. Fernandes was cautioned for careless riding as he moved left-handed when insufficiently clear, causing the rider of MIND HUNTER to take a slight check.

Race 2 - 1:55pm .
THE DESIGNER OUTLET STYLE FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for HAVANA SPRITE to wear a red hood to post.

Leaving the stalls, TOOLATETOEDUCATE, unplaced, jumped left-handed causing the rider of

MARRALYN (IRE), placed third, to take a check. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

One furlong after the start, NAVAL COP, placed fourth, stepped right-handed when racing greenly, giving a slight bump to TOOLATETOEDUCATE, unplaced, causing it to become briefly unbalanced. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of NAVAL COP.

Following the race, Callum Hutchinson reported that NAVAL COP, placed fourth, jumped left-handed from the stalls and ran green.

Race 3 - 2:30pm .

THE POCKETS TOWNHOUSE BATH HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (Bath Summer Sprint Series Qualifier)

Permission was given for SYMBOL OF HOPE and HARRY MOLE to go early, wear a red hood to post.

Inside the final furlong, TITUS THOR, placed fifth, shifted slightly right-handed causing SON OF ASTAR, unplaced, to be moved right-handed off its intended line, which in turn caused SISTERS IN THE SKY, unplaced, to have to switch right-handed off the heels of SON OF ASTAR. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of TITUS THOR.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that SYMBOL OF HOPE, unplaced, lost its right fore shoe and Tyler Heard reported that PHOENIX BEACH (IRE), unplaced, hung right-handed.

Race 4 - 3:05pm .

THE MARSHA NAIFY BRITISH EBF FILLIES' RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (for horses in Bands B, C and D) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for DOODLING and DARK ANGEL LIGHT (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

An enquiry was held to consider interference approximately one furlong out involving, CLEMENTINES STAR, placed third, ridden by William Carver and VELVET GOLDMINE (IRE), placed second, ridden by George Downing. Downing was suspended for 2 days for careless riding as he allowed his mount to drift left-handed, taking CLEMENTINES STAR off its intended line and causing the rider to take a check.

Following the race, Shay Farmer reported that MISS GOLD, unplaced, hung right-handed and the Veterinary Officer reported that SECRET HARVEST, unplaced, lost its left fore shoe.

Race 5 - 3:50pm .

THE SUPPORT BEN SAUNDERS FOUNDATION HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for BLUE HERO (CAN) to go early to post and for HIGHLAND HARVEY (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

An enquiry was held to consider interference inside the final furlong involving, BASILETTE (IRE), unplaced, ridden by George Downing; HIGHLAND HARVEY (IRE), placed fifth, ridden by William Carson and OTTOMAN (IRE), placed third, ridden by Thomas Greatrex. The interference was found to

be accidental as OTTOMAN (IRE) shifted quickly right-handed having been corrected by its rider after moving left-handed, giving a bump to HIGHLAND HARVEY (IRE) and moving it off its intended line, which resulted in BASILETTE (IRE) receiving a bump and being taken off its intended line.

Race 6 - 4:27pm .

THE AL BASTI EQUIWORLD DUBAI HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for SOLAR PHOENIX (IRE) to go early, wear a red hood to post; for THISONESFORYOU, INDIA GOLD (IRE) and BIRD OF WAR (IRE) to wear a red hood to post; for THISONESFORYOU to go early to post.

Approximately one furlong out, MUSICAL SOLDIER (IRE), unplaced, shifted slightly right-handed causing BARBUDA BAY, unplaced, to have to move right-handed to avoid heels, consequently taking BOSOM PALS, unplaced, off intended line. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, William Cox reported that BOSOM PALS, unplaced, was very slowly away; William Carver reported that ANEIRIN'S SWORD (IRE), unplaced, hung left-handed under pressure; Thomas Greatrex reported that DENBY'S DREAM, unplaced, was denied a clear run approaching two furlongs out and the Veterinary Officer reported that BARBUDA BAY, unplaced, lost its right hind shoe.

Race 7 - 5:02pm .

THE BEST FOOTBALL BETTING OFFERS AT freebets.com HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (DIV I)

Permission was given for DADDY CHILL (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Ben Ffrench Davis reported that NAVAL ENSIGN (IRE), placed fourth, hung left-handed and was denied a clear run two furlongs out.

Race 8 - 5:37pm .

THE BEST FOOTBALL BETTING OFFERS AT freebets.com HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (DIV II)

Permission was given for FREEDOM BAY to go early, wear a red hood to post and be mounted in the chute.

The winner, FREEDOM BAY, appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Nottingham on 18 April 2026, where the filly finished tenth of ten runners, beaten 16 lengths. Zoe Hawkins' explanation that FREEDOM BAY had benefitted from the application of cheek pieces and a tongue strap, was noted.

Following the race, Jack Callan reported that DANEHILL STAR (IRE), placed third, ran too free; William Cox reported that BRINTON, unplaced, was slowly away and Tyler Heard reported that POP FAVORITE, unplaced, hung left-handed and moved poorly; the Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race and had nothing to report.
