Race 1 - 2:15pm .**THE MACAN AT PORSCHE CENTRE HULL EBF RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (for horses in Bands C and D) (EBF Restricted Race Qualifier) (GBB RACE)**

Permission was given for DESERT OUTLAW (IRE) to go to post early, and for TAJ MAHAL PALACE and NEEDIN' U to wear a red hood to post.

The Starter reported that UBETTABEQUEEN was unruly in the stalls and withdrawn at 2.15pm. Tim Easterby was informed that the filly could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

Following the race, Billy Garritty reported that NEEDIN' U, unplaced, ran too free.

Race 2 - 2:45pm .**THE 911 AT PORSCHE CENTRE HULL EBF RESTRICTED MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 4) (for horses in Bands B, C and D) (EBF Restricted Race Qualifier) (GBB RACE)**

Permission was given for EMPIRE RISING (IRE), DIPLOMACY and HIGH ON HONEY (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 3 - 3:15pm .**THE CLEARANSWER CALL CENTRES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)**

Permission was given for KING SHARJA to go to post early and for GANTHORPE to wear a red hood to post.

An enquiry was held to consider interference approaching the final ½ furlong, when WILLOWINGHURN, unplaced, ridden by Daniel Tudhope, interfered with GANTHORPE, unplaced, ridden by Joanna Mason. Tudhope was cautioned for careless riding as he had edged right-handed when insufficiently clear, causing Mason to be crowded for room and have to take a slight check.

Following the race, Sean Kirrane reported that BANTZ (IRE), unplaced, ran too free. Daniel Tudhope reported that WILLOWINGHURN, unplaced, was denied a clear run on several occasions inside the final 1½ furlongs.

Race 4 - 3:45pm .**THE JILL WILLOWS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)**

Permission was given for GLENFINNAN (IRE) to go to post early, and for OBELIX, FLYING FLETCHER and HOMESTRAIT (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

The winner GLENFINNAN (IRE), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Thirsk on 1 August 2026, where the gelding finished twelfth of fifteen beaten 9¼ lengths. Michael Dods explained that the gelding may have appreciated the return to Beverley on this occasion, where he has previous course form. His explanation was noted and GLENFINNAN (IRE) was routine tested.

Approaching the final furlong, BELL SHOT (IRE), unplaced, lugged quickly right-handed, as OBELIX, placed fourth, went for a legitimate gap, resulting in OBELIX becoming short of room and the rider having to take a check. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was

involved.

Approaching the final ½ furlong, OBELIX, placed fourth, shifted quickly left-handed, moving INTERVENTION, placed third, slightly off its intended line, which resulted in the rider of TATTIE BOGLE, unplaced, having to take a slight check. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of any horse.

Race 5 - 4:15pm .

THE CAYENNE ELECTRIC AT PORSCHE CENTRE HULL HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for BEARWITH to go to post early, and for NO KNEE NEVER (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Clifford Lee reported that NO KNEE NEVER (IRE), unplaced, was slowly away. David Nolan reported that PRINCESS NIYLA, unplaced, ran too free.

Race 6 - 4:45pm .

THE NATION RADIO YORKSHIRE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for KILFRUSH DESERT (IRE) and LAMLASH BAY to wear a red hood to post.

The performance of ANGEL NUMBERS (IRE), which started joint favourite but finished unplaced beaten 10½ lengths, was considered. The representative of Ruth Carr could offer no explanation for the filly's performance. The Veterinary Officer examined ANGEL NUMBERS (IRE) post-race during routine testing and had nothing to report.

Following the race, Mark Winn reported that SIMBA'S PRIDE (IRE), unplaced, was denied a clear run on several occasions.
