Race 1 - 1:20pm .**THE WILLIAM HILL BILL TURNER MEMORIAL EBF BROCKLESBY STAKES (CLASS 2) (A NOVICE STAKES) (GBB RACE)**

INVINCIBLE ISAAC unseated Pierre-Louis Jamin in the preliminaries. Having been checked by the Veterinary Surgeon and Doctor respectively, both were deemed fit to race.

OCEAN CLUB (IRE) unseated Kevin Stott in the preliminaries. Having been checked by the Veterinary Surgeon and Doctor respectively, both were deemed fit to race.

Approaching 1 furlong out, BLIXEN FORCE (IRE), placed third, hung right-handed making contact with DANCE A JIG, placed second, which in turn gave a bump to BILL THE BULL (IRE), placed fourth, which then moved RLASTHOPE, placed fifth, on to SEATHEGULLS, unplaced, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of any runner.

Following the race, Pierre-Louis Jamin reported that INVINCIBLE ISAAC, unplaced, fly leapt leaving the stalls losing many lengths.

Race 2 - 1:50pm .**THE WILLIAM HILL PRICE BOOSTS EVERY DAY CAMMIDGE TROPHY STAKES (CLASS 1) (Listed Race)**

Permission was given for MONTASSIB to wear a red hood to post.

Race 3 - 2:25pm .**THE WILLIAM HILL EPIC BOOSTS SPRING MILE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2)**

Permission was given for CARRON (IRE), CLASSIC ENCOUNTER (IRE), DESPERATE DAN (IRE), FIRST AMBITION, MEZCALA, PERFECT PART (IRE) and PRINCIPALITY (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Billy Garritty reported that RAINBOW NEBULA (FR), unplaced, never travelled.

Race 4 - 2:57pm .

THE WILLIAM HILL DONCASTER MILE STAKES (CLASS 1) (Listed Race)

Permission was given for TREBLE TEE (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 5 - 3:32pm .

THE WILLIAM HILL LINCOLN (HERITAGE HANDICAP) (CLASS 2)

Permission was given for ANNO DOMINI, BOTANICAL (IRE), ROGUE DIPLOMAT (IRE), TARKHAN (GER), TRIBAL CHIEF (FR) and URBAN LION to wear a red hood to post. Permission was also given for LA TRINIDAD to go early to post.

ORANDI (FR), trained by A.J. Martin had entered the Parade Ring after the signal to mount had been given. After being interviewed, Martin was fined £140.

Inside the final furlong, ETERNAL FORCE, unplaced, hung quickly left-handed as TRIBAL CHIEF (FR), placed third, went for a legitimate gap causing LA TRINIDAD, unplaced, to be moved off its intended line which in turn moved both LA BOTTE, unplaced and GREEK ORDER, unplaced, off their intended line, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Race 6 - 4:05pm .

THE WILLIAM HILL BEST ODDS GUARANTEED MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 3) (GBB/GBBPLUS RACE)

Permission was given for FAEBERON (IRE), TURTY TREE (IRE) and VALENDAY to wear a red hood to post.

It was noted that on the bend leaving the back straight, a dog had run on to the track behind the runners. Having spoken to the Clerk of the Course, he explained that the dog had come from public land outside of the racecourse and they would appoint someone to watch the area in the future.

Following the race, Kevin Stott reported that VALENDAY, unplaced, hung sharply right-handed approximately 1 ½ furlongs out.

Race 7 - 4:40pm .

THE WILLIAM HILL NRMB ON THE GRAND NATIONAL APPRENTICE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (Go Racing In Yorkshire Future Stars Series) (DIV I)

HIBERNATE (IRE) wore earplugs throughout.

Approximately 3 furlongs out, SOVEREIGN APPLAUSE (IRE), unplaced, shifted quickly right-handed causing the winner, MAO SHANG WONG (IRE), to be moved off its intended line which in turn caused ELECTRIC AVENUE, unplaced, to be moved off its intended line, but after viewing a recording of the

incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

An enquiry was held to consider interference inside the final ½ furlong, when the winner, MAO SHANG WONG (IRE), ridden by Connor Whiteley interfered with EXPRESSIONLESS, placed third, ridden by Harry Vigors. Being a 7lb claiming apprentice, Whiteley was accompanied in the enquiry by his jockey coach. Whiteley was cautioned for careless riding as he allowed his mount to drift left-handed without sufficient correction causing Vigors to take a slight check.

Race 8 - 5:15pm .

THE WILLIAM HILL NRMB ON THE GRAND NATIONAL APPRENTICE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (Go Racing In Yorkshire Future Stars Series) (DIV II)

Permission was given for both BEARWITH and RELEVANT RANGE (IRE) to wear a red hood and go early to post. Permission was also given for both MINERS GAMBLE (IRE) and ENDLESS WHISPER to wear a red hood to post.
