Race 1 - 1:55pm .

THE AALBERTS IPS PEGLER VALVES NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for KOHANA NATION (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

The Starter reported that TRIPLE P refused to enter the stalls and was withdrawn at 1:57pm. Tim Easterby was informed that the gelding could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

The Starter reported that SAKURA IMPACT (IRE) refused to enter the stalls and was withdrawn at 1:59pm. Mrs Ilka Gansera-Leveque was informed that the filly could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

Race 2 - 2:30pm .**THE BAPP GROUP OF COMPANIES BAPP NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)**

Permission was given for WELEYFF (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

WELEYFF, trained by Ed Bethell, was late into the parade ring due to a combination of the previous race being several minutes late off, his jockey Oisin Orr riding the winner and being delayed weighing out due to a post-race interview and the colt being difficult to saddle on this occasion.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that EIGHTH IMMORTAL (IRE), placed third, lost its right-fore shoe.

Race 3 - 3:05pm .**THE 7 CORE ELECTRICAL RESTRICTED MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 4) (for horses in Band D) (GBB RACE)**

Permission was given for THEFT (IRE) and TIORA TIME to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Ryan Sexton reported that BEARING IN TIME (IRE), unplaced, was slowly away.

Race 4 - 3:40pm .**THE YATES DRYWALL LTD HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)**

Permission was given for SUPER HIT (FR) to go early to post.

Following the race, Alex Jary reported that WHISKEY PETE (IRE), placed second, fly leapt leaving the stalls.

Race 5 - 4:15pm .**THE WINNERS WEAR SKOPES MENSWEAR HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)**

Permission was given for HAADERR to wear a red hood to post.

Race 6 - 4:50pm .**THE HARRISON COLLEGE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (DIV I)**

Permission was given for MOONHALL LASS (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and for QUEENSMAITE to go early to post.

Approaching the final furlong, GET UP EVERYBODY (IRE), placed third, shifted left-handed away from the whip before being corrected by its rider, briefly moving SPARKLING PINK, unplaced, off its intended line, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of GET UP EVERYBODY (IRE).

Race 7 - 5:25pm .**THE HARRISON COLLEGE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (DIV II)**

Permission was given for VON TROTTER to wear a red hood to post.

Leaving the stalls, MISTER MCGREGOR (IRE), unplaced, jumped left-handed at the same time as GROUNDSMAN (IRE), unplaced, jumped right-handed causing the two runners to bump, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Approaching the final furlong, BARBUDA BAY, placed fifth, lugged left-handed before being corrected by its rider resulting in SPRINTING SPEED (IRE), unplaced, briefly having to be steadied and switched right-handed to continue its run, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of BARBUDA BAY.

Race 8 - 6:00pm .

THE GRACE AND DOTTY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for COME ON OVER (IRE) and STARTLED LADY to wear a red hood to post.

Leaving the stalls, STARTLED LADY, unplaced, jumped very awkwardly and shifted left-handed, hampering MARK'S CHOICE (IRE), unplaced, which was moved notably off its intended line, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

The performance of STARTLED LADY, which finished unplaced, was considered. It was noted that William Knight's representative could offer no explanation for the filly's performance.
