Race 1 - 2:00pm .

THE APRES CHRISTMAS VILLAGE AT DONCASTER RACECOURSE APPRENTICE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for TIGER (FR) and HOLLY MIST (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 2 - 2:30pm .

THE BRITISH STALLION STUDS EBF FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for RANEEM to wear a red hood, for QUISANA (IRE) to go early to post and for ARC LA SHARI to wear a red hood and go early to post.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that ENCHANT (IRE), unplaced, finished lame on its right fore.

Race 3 - 3:00pm .

THE HILTON GARDEN INN DONCASTER "CONFINED" NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 3) (for horses which have

had no more than two runs) (GBB/GBBPLUS RACE)

Approaching the finish line, the winner NOCHEBUENA edged marginally right-handed making light contact with KENNETH, placed second, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of NOCHEBUENA.

Race 4 - 3:30pm .

THE SUMMER SATURDAY SERIES AT DONCASTER RACECOURSE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for NORFOLK BLUE (IRE) and HAKIN ADRAAR to wear a red hood to post.

Approximately 1 furlong out, EYES FRONT (IRE), placed fifth, edged quickly right-handed giving a bump to SURGEON COMMANDER (IRE), placed fourth, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Approaching the line, POPTY PING, unplaced, hung right-handed away from BLACK ROCK BEAUTY (IRE), placed third, at the same time as NORFOLK BLUE (IRE), placed second, hung left-handed, resulting in POPTY PING to become momentarily short for room, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of BLACK ROCK BEAUTY (IRE) or NORFOLK BLUE (IRE).

Following the race, Faye McManoman reported that ROUSHAM, unplaced, hung right-handed under pressure. Daniel Tudhope reported that POPTY PING, unplaced, was denied a clear run on two occasions inside the final furlong.

Race 5 - 4:05pm .

THE GRACE AND DOTTY FEDORAS AND FEATHERS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV I)

Permission was given for JENEVER, TENNESSEE GOLD (FR) and TARDAFF to wear a red hood to post and for BEALE STREET to be mounted in the chute.

Leaving the stalls, MERESIDE MADNESS (IRE), unplaced, jumped left-handed taking MAGIC BOY (GER), placed fourth, of its intended line, which in turn gave a bump to WRYDCROFT, placed third, and GREEN PURSUIT (IRE), placed fifth, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Race 6 - 4:40pm .

THE GRACE AND DOTTY FEDORAS AND FEATHERS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV II)

Permission was given for COMMANDER OF LIFE (IRE), INTERVENTION and MYSTICAL STORM to go early to post wearing a red hood.

The performance of ZIGGY'S CONDOR (IRE), which finished last of twelve runners, was considered. It was noted that Adam Kirby had no explanation for the gelding's performance on this occasion. The Veterinary Officer examined ZIGGY'S CONDOR (IRE) post-race during routine testing and reported the gelding had lost its left fore shoe.

Race 7 - 5:15pm .

THE ROYAL ASCOT TIPS ON attheraces.com HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for RORY'S GOLD (IRE), ONSLOW GARDENS (IRE) and MINI MAC (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and for EY UP HE'S A STAR to go early to post.

Barry McHugh, the rider of GOAL LINE (IRE) was unseated approaching the 2 furlong marker. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no other horse or rider was involved and was caused by the gelding sustaining an injury.

Approximately 1 ½ furlongs out, the winner, WOODLEIGH (IRE) made a legitimate run when EY UP HE'S A STAR, placed third, shifted quickly right-handed taking WOODLEIGH (IRE) further right-handed than intended resulting in HACHIMAN, unplaced, having to take a slight check. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of WOODLEIGH (IRE) or EY UP HE'S A STAR.

Race 8 - 5:45pm .

THE DOWNLOAD THE AT THE RACES APP HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for COME ON OVER (IRE) to wear a red hood to post, for HELLCAT to go early to post and for HENRIETTE RONNER to go early to post wearing a red hood.

SOLAR COOPER, trained by Mark Walford spread a plate on the way to post. As the trainer had not indicated at declaration stage that the gelding should be withdrawn in the event of losing a shoe on the way to post, SOLAR COOPER ran without its left fore shoe.

Leaving the stalls, HENRIETTE RONNER, unplaced, stumbled badly, giving a bump to ANTIQUE BLUE (IRE), unplaced, which in turn resulted in POWER OF CHORA (IRE), unplaced, becoming momentarily short for room, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, David Nolan reported that HENRIETTE RONNER, unplaced, stumbled badly when leaving the stalls and was slow away as a result.
