Permission was given for MAILLOT VERT to be mounted in the chute.

Following the race, Niall Houlihan reported that LEDDERS (IRE), placed third, ran in snatches.

**THE BETGOODWIN ONLINE BOOKIES HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)**

Permission was given for KORUS (FR) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that NOLLYADOR (FR), which was pulled up, had bled from the nose.

**Race 3 - 2:50pm .**
**THE BETGOODWIN HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 5)**

Permission was given for DIAMOND JOEL to be mounted in the chute and go early to post, and for ONNAROLL (FR) to go early to post.

Following the race, Bryan Carver reported that STAFF SERGEANT LEN (GER), unplaced, made a bad mistake at the fourth last hurdle and never travelled thereafter.

**THE BET CLEVER BETGOODWIN HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 5)**

The winner, JACK SPARROW GREY (FR), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Warwick on 20 January 2025 where the gelding finished thirteenth of sixteen, beaten by 26¾ lengths. Gary Moore's explanation that the gelding benefitted from the application of a tongue strap and cheek pieces, quicker ground, officially described as Good, Good to Soft in places and making his chasing debut, was noted. JACK SPARROW GREY (FR) was routine tested.

Following the race, Marc Goldstein reported that MILLIES MITE (IRE), which was pulled up, stopped quickly, the Veterinary Officer examined the mare post-race and had nothing to report.

**Race 6 - 4:30pm .**

**THE BETGOODWIN FREE BET NOSE LOSERS MARES' NOVICES' LIMITED HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 5)**
