Race 1 - 5:30pm .

THE HAMILTON PARK "HANDS AND HEELS" APPRENTICE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (Part of the Racing Excellence Series)

Permission was given for SUMMERSTORMS DREAM (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that SOUTH SHORE ISLAND (IRE), placed fourth, lost its right-fore shoe.

Race 2 - 6:00pm .

THE KINRARA GIN EBF RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (for horses in Bands C and D) (EBF Restricted/Hamilton 2yo Qual) (GBB RACE)

Approaching the final furlong, LONGSHANKS LUKE, placed fourth, shifted quickly right-handed causing BALDETTI (IRE), unplaced, to become short of room and its rider having to take check. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and it had not

improved the placing of LONGSHANKS LUKE.

Following the race, Sean Kirrane reported that BALDETTI (IRE), unplaced, suffered interference approaching the final furlong.

Race 3 - 6:30pm .

THE DAVID & WILLIAM MCHARG MEMORIAL MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for SHEIKHNSHAH (FR) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 4 - 7:00pm .

THE KINRARA DISTILLERY SCOTTISH TROPHY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for DOUBLE PARKED (IRE) to go early to post; ALTAREQ to go early to post wearing a red hood and for IMPARTIALITY to wear a red hood to post.

STRENGTH OF SPIRIT (IRE) wore ear plugs which were removed at the start.

The performance of RETURN TO UNIT, which finished tenth of thirteen runners, was considered. The Veterinary Officer examined RETURN TO UNIT post-race during routine testing and had nothing to report.
